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This paper is an attempt to present a dialect geography of Armenia in the 5th to 9th centuries. It is based on the well known (relative) chronology of the following developments

I. Monophthongization of Class. *aw* (end fifth century)

II. Diphthongization of Class. *e* and *o* (preceding stage I.)

III. Acaryan's Law (ca. 8th century)

IV. Devoicing of Classical voiced stops (early 10th century).

We shall study the geographical reflection of these early developments.
