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This paper is an attempt to present a dialect geography of Armenia in the 5th to 9th centuries. It is based on the well known (relative) chronology of the following developments

I. Monophthongization of Class. aw (end fifth century)

II.Diphthongization of Class. e and o (preceding stage I.)

III.Acaryan's Law (ca. 8th century)

IV.Devoicing of Classical voiced stops (early 10th century).

We shall study the geographical reflection of these early developments.
